

# A COLORFUL, HANDCRAFTED Wedding

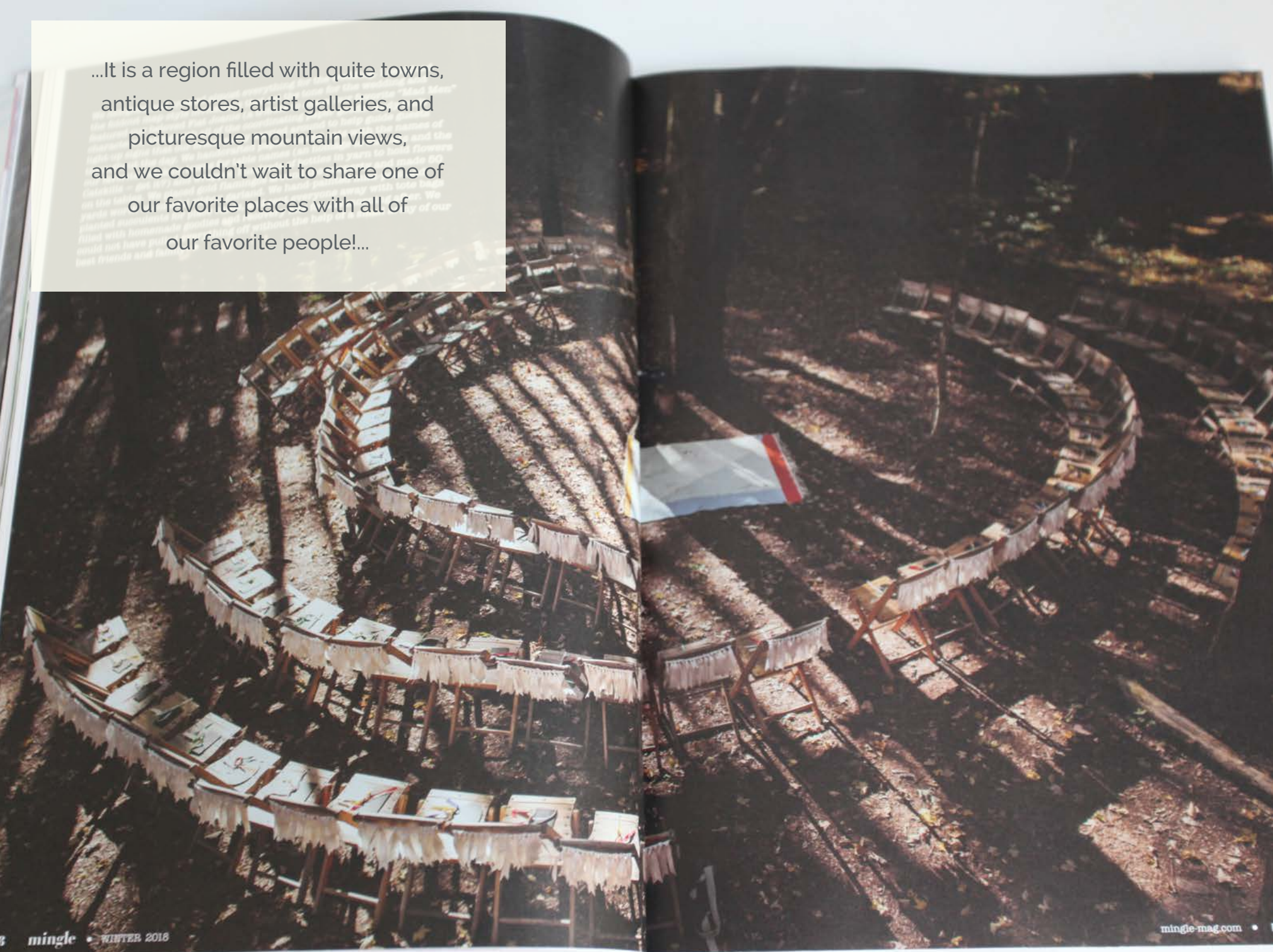
